- Creating a state wide project with the DEEP program for No Child left inside is the community fishing in urban areas. Below is the list of ponds that we have available and need assistance with the program. A clean-up day for each of these lakes is possible.

  - Keney Park Pond, Hartford
  - Lake Wintergreen, Hamden
  - Mohegan Park Pond, Norwich
  - Lakewood Lake, Waterbury
  - Upper Fulton Park Pond, Waterbury
  - Freshwater Pond, Enfield
  - Pickett's Pond, Derby
- Besides the opportunity to stage a clean-up day, we are working with Bill Hyatt, Peter Aarrestad and Mike Beauchene to get permitted to catch legal size Pan Fish and Bass from other CT lakes and help "stock" these ponds for the local kids.
- This would allow the CBN to accomplish the following:
  - Have an organized statewide project that is easy for clubs to join
  - Clubs can add to the project by combining this with:
    - Youth Event by having kids fish with them
    - Clean up the lake they are fishing
  - Working with the state DEEP to build on our foundation
  - Get publicity for the project (DEEP wants media coverage)
  - Helps up promote fishing and encourage fishing to more youths
- Next Steps:
  - Have clubs choose a body of water and volunteer to be lake stewards for the lake
    - Mohawk Valley Bass Casters signed up for Upper Fulton Park Pond, Waterbury
  - Hopeful to hold the event the weekend of August 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>
