#### Conservation Report: Dean Rustic

- CAC Meeting Bill Hyatt reported
  - o Brood Stock Salmon dropped another 100 in Naugatuck River (1800 YTD)
  - Brood Stock Trout put in Beach Pond, Black Pond, Mashapaug, Stillwater Pond, Squantz Pond, West Hill Pond and West Side Pond
  - This past year 1800 kids signed up for the Fishing Passport
    - They will be adding 6 more community lakes for next year
- Fishing Advocacy Working directly with CT DEEP to promote fishing with these various initiatives
  - o Bass Program

•

- Removal of small bass from donor lakes into community lakes
- Trial run this weekend to run through procedures
- Fear is that we may not catch any small fish
- CT BASS Nation CARES
  - Specific training day set for February 8<sup>th</sup> at Cabela's
  - Applications are due on January 24<sup>th</sup> and may be filled out electronically but must be printed and signed in ink per requirements for state police background checks. DEEP will send out new instructor training packets to all applicants. Packets will contain a DVD to preview, an agenda for training session and directions to the training
  - CARE Instructors once certified are committed to participate in at least one CARE class or event every year. They have certified over 650 instructors since 1986.
  - Also included is a "Family Fishing Class" agenda. These are the subjects that are taught to our students. You will notice that these are the very basics.

#### Boating Advisory: Dean Rustic

- Hearing on Lake Warmaug 6mph limit had only 13 attendees and only 38 email/mail comments
  - DEEP extending comments until December 31<sup>st</sup>

- DEEP very impressed with Naggi & Brothers who are doing the work on Lilinonah. They have started paving the lot. The project was 1.2 million and 75% came from Wallop-Boroux funds
- MTA looking to get 6 million to dredge New Haven Harbor
- There was a little glitch in the system to get your boating certificates to print electronically. They should now print out on your fishing licenses.
- December 11<sup>th</sup> there is a meeting for the CLA and the Zebra Mussel Task Force. There is a new way to fight the Zebra Mussels using CO2 in the Pipe coming from Laurel Lake.
- Hartford Boat Show will have the guys from Wicked Tuna coming
- CBN presented the request for updating the launch at Squantz Cove. Feedback is that it is not on the radar and the next boat launch scheduled is in Branford. DEEP alternates between Fresh and Saltwater. Plan is for updating Lattens not Squantz.
- CBN Expressed concern over the growing number of private swim areas on public lakes. Discussion was help and they will look into the matter. All permitted swim areas need to have the permit number. If you do not see a permit number, report it to the DEEP.
- CBN has asked to look at the HP restrictions on lakes and has asked to have a speed limit instead. This is good timing as the Governor is asking for a task force to streamline regulations or remove old ones.

# C.L.A Report: Chris Bielert

- Lake level is currently at 427 feet
- CLA Technical committee will be meeting to discuss and make a recommendation to First Light for this year's drawdown
- Hazard Buoys have been removed please use caution
- Candlewood has been affected by an unusually large Blue-Green Algae (Cyanobacteria) bloom this season
  - Suspect the record summer temperatures and a warm fall lake are likely causes.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Algae is caused by excess nutrients in the water  $\;$ 
    - Nutrients come from many places like leaves from trees and runoff
    - There are potential human and animal health issues with some blue-green algae blooms. Please go to the DEEP website to learn about the hazards. To learn about Blue-Green Algae in general go to <u>www.ctlakes.org</u>
- CLA is looking for any signs of Zebra Mussels in Candlewood Lake this season. If you have any information regarding Zebra Mussels in the lake please let me know so that I can pass along the information
- There is an Invasive Species Subcommittee meeting on December 11<sup>th</sup> that I will be attending. Topics of discussion will be Zebra Mussels in Lilinonah and Zoar, winter drawdowns, Eurasion Milfoil and possible control methods of Blue-Green Algae

# OLD BUSINESS:

- Excused absences: Bass Busters
- Nominations for Treasurer and Secretary were turned in by Sal Messina
  - Nominations are: Rachel Rose for Secretary and Marc Levesque for Treasurer
  - Voting will take place at the December meeting
- CBN Roster and dues were due at the October meeting and due to BASS Nation online by November 1<sup>st</sup>. Remember to use the correct form completely filled out (available on <u>www.ctbass.com</u>) Be sure your club name is on the check and that it is the right amount. Members over 60 that have been with us 5 years or more are \$25.00 and all others are \$50.00. IT WILL BE REFUSED IF IT IS NOT ON THE PROPER FORM AND COMPLETELY FILLED OUT. Must update online before November 30<sup>th</sup> to avoid interruption of the magazines.
- Bylaw proposals were passed out in October and brought back to your clubs. Much discussion was held, Al Guite, Bylaw Chairperson answered many questions. We will vote on Bylaw proposals at the December meeting (each club gets 1 vote).

- CBN Bylaw change proposal 2014 -1
  - **Institute a new section to the bylaw as Article XII, B, 3, d.** Note: each lettered paragraph including the current Article XII, B, 3, d which will follow this addition will be re lettered accordingly in an ascending manor. (I.e. if adopted the current Article XII, B, 3, d will become Article XII, B, 3, e and so on)
    - **Proposed Addition:** d. Linked Entries: Boaters, entering the Two Day State Championship, who identify a linked non-boater on their tournament application, will guarantee use of their boat during both days of competition provided that their linked non-boater is physically present during both days of the event. In the event that a boater's linked non-boater fails to show up on a competition day the Tournament Director and their designated committee will adjust the pairings accordingly and if at all possible the linked boater will be paired with a non-linked boater. In the event that a non-boaters linked boater fails to show up on a competition day the linked non-boater will be ineligible to participate in that days competition. Entry fees for linked anglers

(boater/non-boater) must accompany the tournament application.

- CBN Bylaw change proposal 2014 -2
  - Revision to Article XII, B, 3, c: Current wording c. A properly completed and signed application fee must be postmarked by a mailing deadline determined by the Tournament Director
    - **Proposed Change**: Application process A properly completed and signed application, along with any additional documentation that is required by the CBN and/or State Agencies, plus the full entry fee must be sent in one complete package and postmarked by a mailing deadline determined by the Tournament Director. Failure to provide all required documentation by the mailing deadline may deem the individual or individuals ineligible to participate. It is encouraged that each CBN club, send all application documentation and fees in one combined package for all of their members who will be participating in this event.
- The President and Youth Director went to the Nationals at Lake Dardanelle, Russellville, Arkansas on October 23<sup>rd</sup> October 27<sup>th</sup>. Paul Mueller has won and will be representing CT at the BASSMASTERS Classic!! Noah Winslow has also made us very proud by finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> and bringing home a \$2,000.00 scholarship.
