2. Fisheries Advisory Council INTRODUCTION TO MASON TRUMBLE & Q&A – DEPUTY COMMISSIONER OF RECREATION AND NATURAL RESOURCES

 Mason introduced himself, provided background, and talked about priorities.

• The question was asked how his administration will implement a EEJ issues. Mason said that his priority is connecting urban centers to nature and ensuring access is equitable. Rick said that he has everyone thinking about what leadership wants to tackle in the near term and beyond.

One member expressed gratitude that the focus will be on access as loss of access is a big issue on the shoreline for surfcaster.
He was asked how he plans to diversify the workforce. He acknowledged that it is tough but its important start with the internal culture to make sure itsinclusive. It's important to make the connections with the pipelines. Asked the group that if they have a connection with someone who can assist, please pass the information on to him.

• Questions from members on What percentage of potentially harvestable population is dying each year due to mortality after release? Ed has put together some population estimates on select high-pressure lakes to see what level these populations may be impacted during the spawn. He has put more numbers in from C&R mortalities but has to continue running the numbers to get a better picture.

Would any thought be given to barbless hooks or type of hook to decrease mortality from C&R? DEEP has had brief, internal discussions on this but needs further discussion. Imposing circle hooks on bait fishing may prove most effective. Jason said that they've been studying lure size in Texas and the impact on mortality.

Pete is hoping to get some data, although it may not be as robust due to staffing levels. * There seemed to be a consensus that an earlier opening day seems to work well. * Is there data from other states that have done a more recent elimination of opening day? * In terms of 2021, DEEP staff has been asked to develop a plan for an earlier opening day.

• Marine Fisheries Report –Justin Davis o Menhaden & Quotas were set and it was a positive outcome for Menhaden. The populations are currently in excellent shape thanks to management decisions over the years. * Reports of menhaden fish kills. They currently think it is a natural occurrence. There are many factors that may be contributing. NY is analyzing fish. * The occurrence of the kills is throughout the state. Where the kills have occurred there are more live fish than dead fish.

o Striped bass – Public outreach push on circle hooks. Had to get something in place by January 1st. DEEP used emergency regulation process to meet mandate and is currently in place. Focus will be on education and outreach, not necessarily enforcement, which will be difficult. The challenge is that the nuances (such as the what defines natural bait) have not yet been worked out.
