Information from this past Month -

1. CT Conservation Advisory Council (CCAC) Meeting

Fisheries Update: Provided by Pete Aarrestad, Fisheries Division Director

- a. The DEEP "Winterfest" was held at Burr Pond (Torrington) on Saturday 2/1 from 10:00 AM 3:00 PM.
- b. The Fisheries Division will be stocking ~10,000 brook trout to reduce crowding in the hatchery. Will be stocked into lakes and ponds having safe ice. Also expect to be stocking some rainbow trout later in the winter.
- c. The annual fish stocking report is available on the DEEP website. 579,820 total catchable size trout were stocked in 2024 plus an additional 1,987 Atlantic salmon (including 372 large broodstock salmon).
- d. For marine recreational fishing all of the regulations will remain the same for 2025 as in 2024, except for a minor change in the opening date for black sea bass. The date change for black sea bass was needed so that the opening will fall on a Saturday.
- e. A supply of the 2025 Inland Fishing Guides have been printed in both English and Spanish and will soon be available in town halls and some tackle shops. This is a simplified guide designed specifically to provide information on the fishing rules.
- f. Review of the Aquatic Invasive Species (AIS) Grant applications is underway. Expect that the review committee will complete its work this week and that grants will be announced by March. Anticipate awarding between \$300,000 and \$400,000 in grant funds for 2025.
- g. CCAC question: When a boater purchases an AIS Stamp decal for their boat (\$20 + \$5 processing fee) Does this cover anyone who can legally operate the boat?

- a. Response: Yes. The AIS Decal covers all legal operators of the boat whereas the \$7 individual stamp only covers the person who purchased it.
