- CBN Conservation Report March 26, 2025 Information from this past Month -
- 1. CT Conservation Advisory Council (CCAC) Meeting Fisheries **Update: Provided by Pete Aarrestad, Fisheries Division Director**
- a. The Governor's FY 26/27 budget calls for a \$500,000/yr cut to the fish hatchery line item.

- b. All of the 2025 marine fishing regulations will be the same as in 2024.
- c. Anglers are reminded that they need to put their names and addresses on tip ups.
- d. Review of what's happening at Lake Wononscopomuc in Salisbury: The town won't be allowing any boats to launch except those that are to be kept on-site throughout the season. This is to prevent hydrilla from being introduced. The lake is open to ice fishing. DEEP continued the full allotment of trout stocking during 2024 but is going to do an 80% reduction for 2025. Stocking 500 rainbows this winter to enhance ice fishing.
- e. New Fishing Tournament Policy: Any club issued a fishing tournament permit for a lake that is known to have hydrilla, will not be issued a tournament permit for another lake until 10 days have passed. This is a pilot program designed to help slow the spread of hydrilla to additional CT waters. Ten days is the dry time for being certain that hydrilla is no longer viable. The Agency is aware that there are other vectors involved in the spread of hydrilla (ex. other boats and waterfowl). Part of the intent of this new rule is to prevent efforts by local residents and municipalities to eliminate fishing tournaments and/or public access.
